Right to Education Act in India:

The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 came into effect on 1st April 2010.

Education now becomes a fundamental right – a historical milestone, as India joins a few countries in the world with this historic law.

As per the Act, all educational institutions reserve 25% seats for children from weaker sections of society. It must be noted that Loreto schools in India have long been implementing this policy for about 20 years or more, reserving 20% admission seats to poor and underprivileged children. While we welcome the noble ideals enshrined in the Act, some of its clauses, however, has generated genuine apprehension about its effectiveness. Also sections 21 & 22 violate the educational rights of minorities as safeguarded in *Article 30(1) of the Constitutions.*

Placements: With the transfer of Sr. Marian Vase to Loreto School, Ranchi, Sr. Phyllis Morris will take over as Principal of Loreto Convent School, Entally, while retaining charge of the Senior boarders there. It is hoped that Sr. Phyllis will get help in the school and boarding to enable her to undertake the extra responsibility. Thank you, Phyllis, for your generous acceptance of this appointment.
